1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-16.
- 1.2 Boats participating in this regatta shall conform to the Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS) 2013 2016, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising is permitted subject to the limitations of ISAF Regulation 20.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 In accordance with the ISAF Regulation 19 (Eligibility Code), all competitors (helmsperson and crew) shall be members in good standing of a Yacht Club affiliated to and in good standing
 - with SA Sailing or their Member National Authority in the case of non-South Africans. The Yacht Club name and membership details be stated on the entry form.
- 3.2 The regatta is open to all dinghies and catamarans.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form.

4. FEES

4.1 Required fees: R350 per boat

Fees payable on registration.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration will take place from 08.00 to 10:00 am on Saturday 6 July 2024
- 5.2 A compulsory skippers briefing will be held at 11h00 on Saturday 6 July 2024
- 5.3 The warning signal for the first race will not be before 12:00 on Saturday 6 July 2024

6 THE COURSES

6.1 The courses will be displayed at shipper meeting.

7. NUMBER OF RACES

7.1 The number of races scheduled shall be a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 12.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS Rule 44 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

multihull classes only. Rule 44 will apply to all mono hull yachts.

9. SCORING

for

- 9.1 Low Point System as described in RRS Appendix A4.1 will apply.
- 9.2 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of
 - her race scores.
 - (b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races excluding her two worst scores.

10. SAFETY

10.1 Yachts shall comply with their class buoyancy and safety requirements.

10.2 All competitors shall always wear a personal buoyancy aid, while afloat in a yacht.

10.3 Wet or dry suits do not constitute adequate buoyancy.

11. PRIZES

11.1 Frostbite Cup will be presented.

11.2 Other prizes and trophies may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing committee.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.

12.2 See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the Organizing Authority nor any of its officials or

other

persons associated with the organization and running of the event shall be held responsible or will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

Each participating boat is encouraged to carry sufficient valid third-party liability insurance to cover any liability arising during the event.
